COVID-19 symptom checker and free testing sites

Healthy Blue providers should be aware the CDC has created a Coronavirus Self-Checker, an interactive clinical assessment tool that will assist individuals ages 13 and older, and parents and caregivers of children ages 2 to 12, in deciding when to seek testing or medical care if they suspect they, or someone they know, has contracted COVID-19 or has come into close contact with someone who has COVID-19. The online, mobile-friendly tool asks a series of questions and, based on the user's responses, provides recommended actions and resources.
